## Details about our two Seders:

Traditional Seder on April 18 / 15 Nisan at 7:00 PM

Political Seder on April 19 / 16. Nisan at 7:00 PM

The first Seder, on April 18, led by Worship Leader Daniel Kempin, will follow our traditional format.

In our second Seder, on April 19, we will offer a “political Seder” led by Rabbi Elisa Klapheck. This innovation was inspired by our members, who are cordially invited to help create this Seder.

Our intention:

Every year we celebrate Pesach by following in the footsteps of our ancestors and reliving the Exodus as though it were happening to us directly.

This requires us to recognize oppression and injustice in today’s world.

- Where do we stand this year?
- Where should our path take us this year and what should our journey include?
- Does it just pertain to us as Jews?
- Do we travel this path as individuals, as Jews, or as human beings in a global world?

The structure of the second Seder will follow the traditional Haggada, with the four children, the four questions, the four glasses, etc. We will also sing all the songs. But instead of discussions on the texts of our ancient Rabbis, we will discuss texts and theories that pertain to Pesach today.

We plan to create our own Haggada for this Seder.
